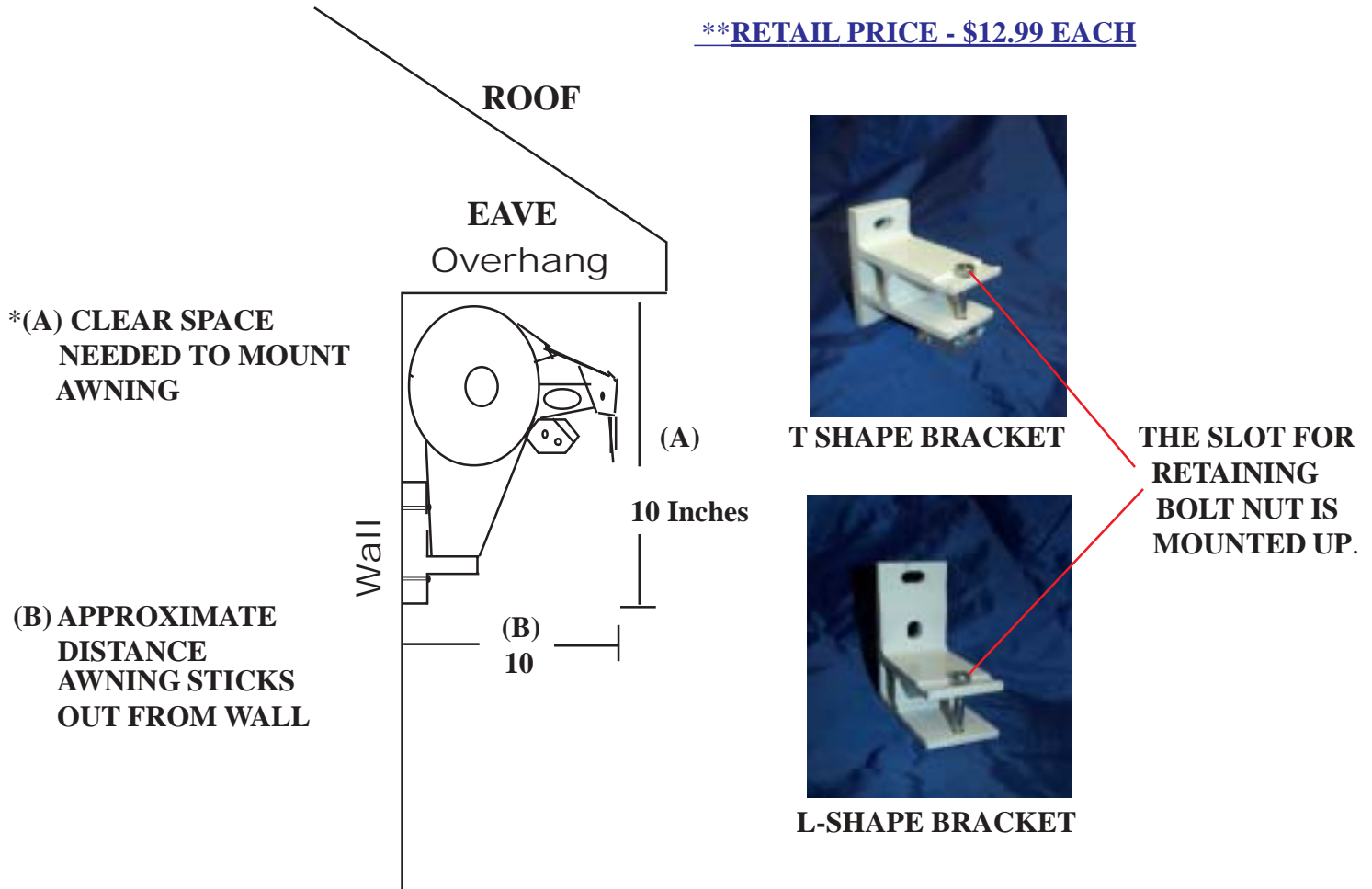


## King Canopy Awning Wall Mounting Brackets

(DIAGRAM BELOW IS NOT TO SCALE)

The illustration below shows an awning mounted on the wall under an eave of a structure. It illustrates that 10'' will be needed for this application. The mounts may be used to secure an awning on any structurally sound wall.



**\* NOTE: WHEN MOUNTING ELECTRIC MODULAR AWNING ALLOW 14'' FOR (A) IN DIAGRAM ABOVE. THIS WILL ALLOW ACCESS TO THE INNER AND OUTER LIMIT SWITCHES ON TOP OF MOTOR.**

King Canopy Awnings come standard with wall mounting brackets. Brackets come in two shapes. (See Pictures Above) The awning could be packed with either of the brackets. One is T-Shape with one mounting hole on top and one on bottom. The L-Shape has both mounting holes on top. Both brackets function the same. When measuring for clear space, using either bracket, always measure from bottom of bracket. (See (A) in diagram)

**12', 14' 16' - 4 Wall Brackets**

**18' - 5 Wall Brackets**
