Letter to Client After Court Hearing

Description:

This generalized letter is provided to clients immediately after their court hearings. It advises clients to remain cooperative in preparation of their case, and references that they also have been provided three other documents in conjunction with this letter: (1) the hearing notice for their next court hearing; (2) the Asylum Checklist; and (3) an individualized list of documents/instructions tailored to the specific case. This letter provides a general roadmap for the client until the next hearing, advising him or her to undertake certain steps that cannot be accomplished last-minute, such as fingerprinting, securing witnesses, etc.

Note:

This document apprises the client of how to proceed after an initial court hearing/filing; further review of the file should be made at a later time, and further communication with the client is necessary to ensure he or she is following the instructions to completion in a timely manner.
