

# Instructions

## BLIK BLOK

### Contents

29 natural wood blocks.

100 Blik Blok Cards with solutions.

### Object

Create the 3D designs on the Blik Blok cards using the blocks shown on each card's front. The front of each card contains a 3D design to be created using specific blocks. The reverse side shows the solution. There are four challenge levels: Beginner (orange), Intermediate (yellow), Advanced (green) and Expert (red). Each level has 25 designs and presents new challenges. As you advance to more difficult designs that use more blocks and introduce new concepts, be sure to apply the knowledge you've gained from previous levels.

### Begin by choosing a card

Find the blocks needed to complete the design as indicated on the front of each card. Stack, sort and manipulate the blocks until you have

created the design on the card. The solution to creating the design is on the back of the card. The dashed lines indicate the direction in which the blocks could be placed together in order to create the design. The BLUE dashed lines indicate the direction in which the blocks could be moved. The RED dashed lines indicate that the blocks could be placed at an angle.

Blik Blok is an exercise in strengthening your visual and spatial thinking skills. Things aren't always what they seem. For example, when placed together, two triangles can make a square, or two of the wedge pieces can fit together to make a solid rectangle, etc.

**IMPORTANT:** You are using wood blocks to create designs that have been generated using computer aided drafting (CAD) software. While the designs are represented as solid objects on the cards, the finished object is comprised of several 3D blocks and will have seams and layers and may even look disjointed. This variation between the printed piece and the 3-D version will add to your challenge.
