- ◆ The Paratrooper® Mountain Bike is superior to other folding bikes because it is **full size, with 26" wheels** and has a rigid aluminum frame, as well as many other standard parts. This makes for easy service and repair.
- ◆ The **patented Folding Integrated Technology™ (FIT)**, developed by Montague, allows the Paratrooper® to fold without breaking or cutting any of the frame tubes. This preserves the structural integrity and inherent strength of the bicycle frame design and geometry.
- ◆ The Paratrooper® is **convenient and easy to store** in a closet, vehicle, plane or boat. The military use them because they can be easily carried for airdrops, thrown in the back of a truck, or strapped to the side of a tank. Many civilian Montague bike owners find their bikes **easy to travel with** on trains and commercial airline flights.
- ◆ The Paratrooper® arrives in a box, fully tuned and **ready to ride**. Kick stands are available upon request as are folding pedals which take 4 inches off the width of the folded bike.
- ◆ When traveling by commercial plane, the \$90 bike fee can be avoided by packing and checking the Paratrooper® in the **Airliner Hard Case** for protected and safe shipping. **A soft carrying case** is also a perfect accessory, simply fold the bike, zip up the bag, and carry the Paratrooper® comfortably with the padded shoulder strap.
