Celebrate Adoption!

In 2013, 54 cats and dogs were adopted from PAWS. Our rules are a bit stricter than at other organizations. Our cats must be inside only cats and anyone wishing to adopt a dog must have a fenced back yard.

PAWS helped 35 people from Muskogee County with a low-cost spay/neuter program. Another entity has a grant to help with spay/neuter vouchers within city limits so our efforts focus on Muskogee County residents outside the Muskogee city limits.



Green PAW update

For the whole year of 2011 PAWS did very well with our recycling program. We made \$1,313.03. But we did even better in 2012, we earned \$1,613.02. For 2013 the total was slightly down to \$1,125.29.

We would like to thank Yaffe Iron & Metal for working with us. This makes about our 8th year to do our recycling program.

Onions: All of the plants in the *Allium* family -- onions, leeks, chives, garlic, shallots, and ramps -- contain a substance called N-propyl disulphide, which destroys a cat's red blood cells and causes fatal anemia.

Candy & Gum: The artificial sweetener xylitol, which is found in toothpaste and in many sugar-free candies and gums, can cause a dangerous drop in your cat's blood sugar and even lead to liver failure.

Grapes & Raisins: Although scientists aren't sure exactly what makes grapes and raisins toxic to cats, the fact remains that they are. If a cat eats these fruits, kidney failure will result. Even a small amount will make your cat sick.

Chocolate: Chocolate contains theobromine, which causes abnormal heartbeat, tremors, seizures, and death. Theobromine is in every kind of chocolate, even white chocolate, but dark chocolate and unsweetened baker's chocolate are the most dangerous.

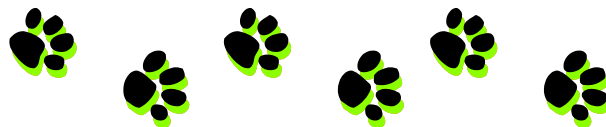

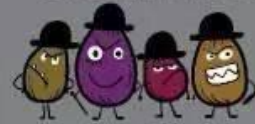

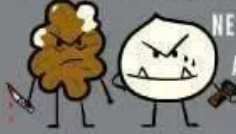
