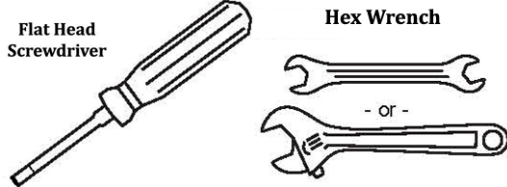


RAIN OR SHINE NEWSPAPER HOLDER ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for purchasing a “Rain or Shine”™ Newspaper Holder. We know you’ll be satisfied with the years of service it will provide.

Recommended Tools (not included):



The following hardware is provided with the Rain or Shine Newspaper Holder:

4 pcs. 8-32 x 3/8” with nuts

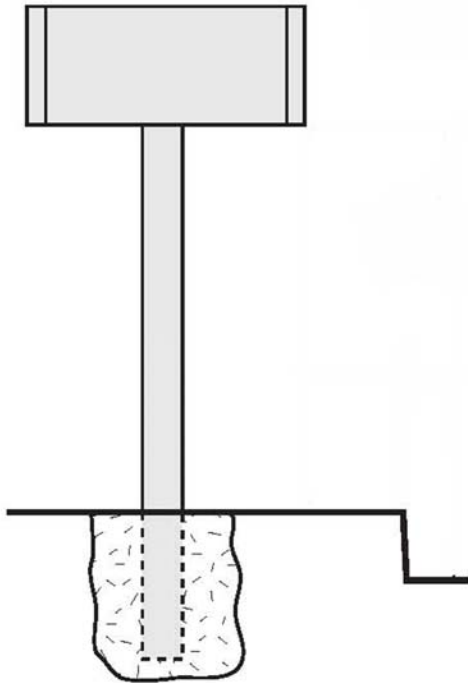
4 pcs. Washers

1 pc. 1/4” x 2-1/2”

1 pc. 1/4” Cap Nut

For Standard In-Ground Installation:

Be careful not to puncture water, sewer, gas, or any other utility lines when digging.



Dig a hole deep enough to allow the Newspaper Holder to sit at the desired height. The bottom of the hole for the concrete may be filled with several inches of gravel to promote drainage under the post.

Slide the post over the ground spike and align the mounting holes. Secure post and base using the 2.5” screw and cap nut.

Insert the post and rotate to achieve the desired orientation of the Newspaper Holder. Pour the concrete (at least 1 cubic foot recommended) completely around the base of the post, making sure the post remains level and correctly positioned. Allow the concrete to set.

After the concrete has set, attach the Newspaper Holder to the support plate on the top of the mounting post using the 8-32 x 3/8” screws.

For Standard Surface Installation:

If using concrete anchors in preexisting concrete, make sure the anchor positions allow for the mounting of the Post Base. The Post Base is designed to be mounted to a surface, not buried into the ground. Before you install the post you must first have a suitable mounting surface. A concrete surface is strongly recommended. The surface should be slightly above ground level to prevent water from pooling around the post base.

If you have a pre-existing concrete pad, you can install the post using anchor bolts designed to be inserted into cured concrete. Please refer to the instructions that come with the anchor bolts to properly install anchors.

If you need to make new concrete footing, you can set suitable anchor bolts directly into the concrete before it cures.

In any case, make sure the anchors are installed to match the locations of the four holes in the post base (6" x 2.5" mounting bolt pattern).

After the concrete has set, attach the post base to the mounting surface prepared earlier. Secure the base using the nuts and washers included with your anchors.

Slide the post over the base and align the mounting holes. Secure post and base using the 2.5" screw and cap nut.

Attach the Newspaper Holder to the support plate on the top of the mounting post using the 8-32 x 3/8" screws.

Cleaning instructions:

The "Rain or Shine"TM Newspaper Holder is made of aluminum with tough powder coat finish to withstand exposure to the elements. To clean your Newspaper Holder, use a non-abrasive detergent and water with a cloth or a sponge.
