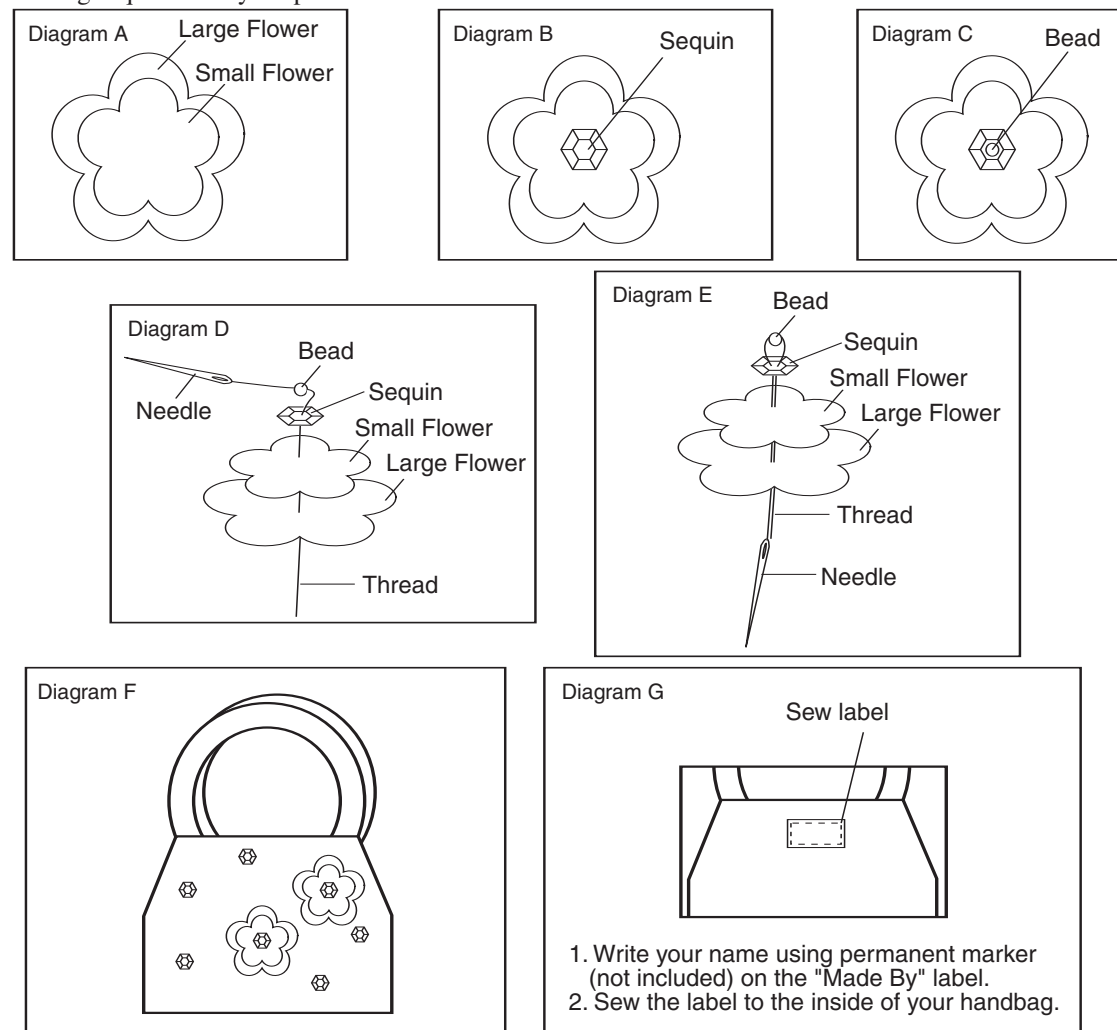


How To Decorate Your Purse

1. Select felt flowers and layer the small ones on top of the large ones. (See Diagram A).
2. Put a sequin in the center on top of the flowers. (See Diagram B).
3. Put a bead in the center of the sequin. (See Diagram C).
4. Using your sewing needle and thread, pass the needle from the back of the flower through to the front. Put the needle through the hole in the sequin and then the hole in the bead (See Diagram D).
5. Pass the needle back through the hole in the sequin, through to the back of the flower (See Diagram E).
6. Do this two or three times and knot at the back of the flower.
7. Sew flowers onto purse. (See Diagram F). Sew additional sequins onto purse.
8. Write your name on the label and sew to the inside of your handbag (Diagram G).
9. Sew remaining sequins onto your purse.



Helpful Hints

1. If yarn becomes stuck on top of needle, push it back to release.
2. Do not turn the crank handle to hard to too fast, as this may damage the machine.
3. You must maintain proper tension on the yarn through the tension piece, otherwise you may drop a stitch.
4. When starting out, be sure that the yarn is fed properly through the notch in the feeder.
5. If you use yarn in your knitting machine that is not included in this set, do not use yarn that is textured or lumpy. Smooth yarn works best.
6. As you turn the handle, pull out your knitted piece from underneath. Watch out for twisting.

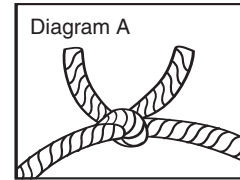
YOUR SET INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:



Put the switch on the front of your Knitting Machine in the up position to knit flat panels.
Helpful Hint: Your Knitting Machine knits approximately 6 rows per inch.

How To Make A Handbag With Plastic Handles

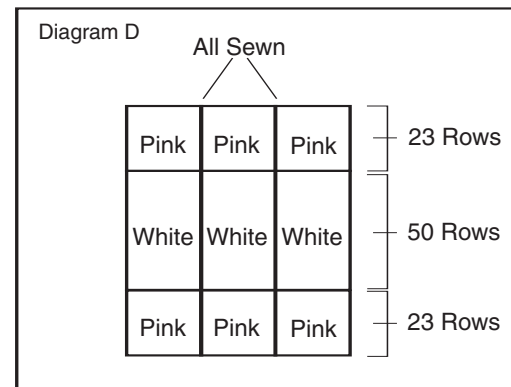
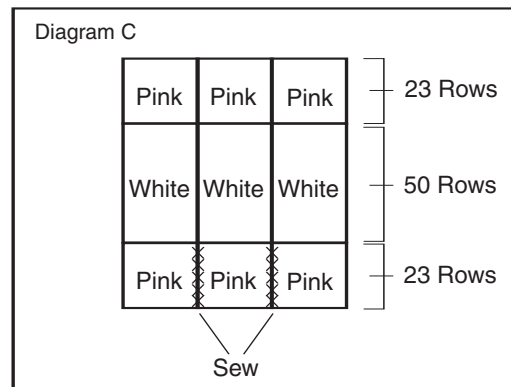
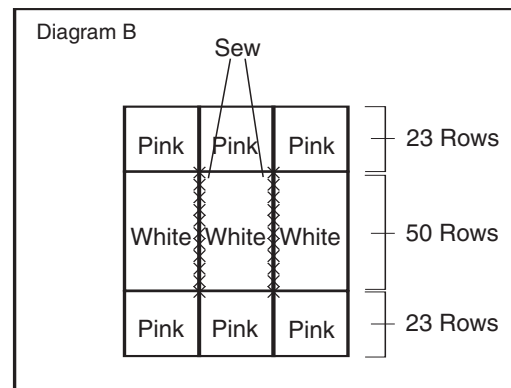
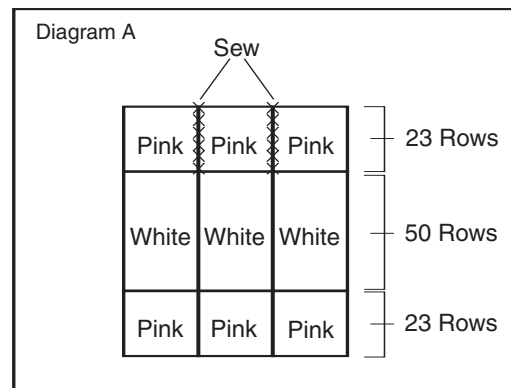
1. Set your Knitting Machine to knit flat panels.
2. Knit 23 rows (4", 10 cm) using pink yarn.
3. After you knit 23 rows, change yarn colors. To change colors, cut the pink yarn and tie on the white yarn in a tight knot at the bottom of the tension feeder. Knit slowly and carefully until the knot has made a complete rotation. (See Diagram A). Continue to knit.
4. Knit 50 rows (8 1/3", 21 cm) using white yarn. After you knit 50 rows, change colors again, back to pink.
5. Knit another 23 rows using pink yarn.
6. When complete, remove the flat panel from the Knitting Machine by following the instructions in the manual that came with your Knitting Machine.



Make two more panels as described above. When complete, you will have a total of three panels.

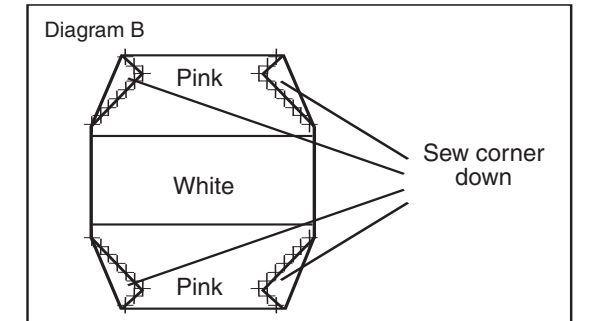
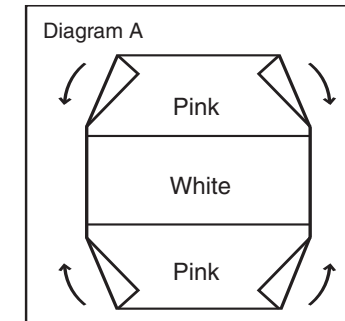
How To Sew Your Panels Together

1. Align the long sides of all three panels.
2. Using your plastic sewing needle and pink yarn, stitch together the top pink edges. (See Diagram A).
3. Now stitch together the white sections using white yarn. (See Diagram B).
4. Change back to pink yarn and stitch together the bottom pink panels. (See Diagram C).
5. You now have one large piece. (See Diagram D).



To Prepare Your Panel To Be Lined

1. Place panel flat on a table, with the seams facing up.
2. Fold in all four corners as shown. (See Diagram A).
3. Stitch down all four corners using your plastic sewing needle and pink yarn. (See Diagram B).



To Attach The Liner

1. Take the fabric rectangle and lay next to the knitted piece, face down.
2. Fold the top edge 1/4" (.6 cm) in. Stitch the folded edge of the fabric to the edge of the knitted piece using your metal sewing needle and thread (See Diagram A and B). Repeat on all sides.
3. Place the entire piece flat on a table, with the lining facing up. Put one ring at one end. (See Diagram C).
4. Fold the edge of the knitted piece over the ring and sew down the edge to hold the ring in place. (See Diagram C).
5. Repeat at the other end.
6. Fold entire piece in half and stitch sides together (See Diagram D). Leave 1 1/2" (3.8 cm) open at the top (below the rings), as shown.
