

Read all cautions before lighting candles made with this set. Adult supervision required!

CANDLE LIGHTING CAUTIONS:


Adult supervision required at all times when lighting candles!

Only use candles and wax included in this set with the glass votives.

Light only one candle at a time inside glass votive. Before lighting, set glass votive in aluminum pan (included), filled with water. Set aluminum pan with candle on a secure, flat surface. Never place candle on the floor! You may trip and cause a serious accident. Light candle away from flammable materials such as curtains, blankets, rugs, loose clothing, long hair, paper, etc. Never light candle near paper of any kind. Always light candle in an open area, but away from an drafts, vents and open windows. Never put fingers in hot wax or near the flame. Hot wax can burn sensitive skin. Do not attempt to move candle after lighting. Do not touch glass jar when candle is lit. It may be too hot to touch. Trim wick to avoid carbon build up and smoky flame. Keep wax pool free from wick trimmings and other debris, such as match heads. Do not leave burning candle unattended. Keep candles away from children and pets.

GETTING STARTED

Using powdered wax is a safe, fun way to create colorful candles. No heating or melting of the wax is required. Use only the powdered wax included in this kit to fill the jars.



1. Select one of the glass votives and set it inside the aluminum pan. The aluminum pan will catch any excess powdered wax that may accidentally spill as you fill the glass.






2. With adult supervision, cut off one corner of the bag of powdered wax. This makes a spout to pour the wax.


To reseal the bags: A rubber band or a piece of tape can be used to re-seal the opening after using. Keep the different colors of wax separate and in their bags.

CREATING A CANDLE



Fill the glass votive with layers of colorful wax.

- **1.** Pour a little of one color wax at a time into the glass votive.
- 2. After each color of wax is added, check to see if any wax accidentally spilled into the aluminum pan under the glass votive. Pour the excess wax back into the bag of powdered wax. Set the glass votive over the empty aluminum pan again, and continue to fill the glass with a new color of wax.
- **3.** Add as many colorful layers as you like. After each new layer, gently pat the wax down with your fingers.




The detailing stick can be used to make designs in the wax.

- 1. To make designs with the detailing stick, pour at least 3 layers of colored wax into the jar.
- 2. Slide the stick along the inside of the glass and down through the layers of wax. As you lift the stick out of the wax, the top color of wax will dip into the layers below.

Note: Do not make dips in the middle of the jar. The designs will not be seen from the outside of the glass.

3. Fill the jar almost to the top with wax.




Insert a candle into the center of the wax.

- 1. Insert one candle into the center of the glass votive that has been filled with powdered wax. Push the candle into the wax as far down as it will go.
- 2. With your fingers, press the wax firmly around the candle. Make sure that the candle is as close to the center of the glass as possible and that there is enough powered wax around the candle to keep it standing straight.

SAFE CANDLE LIGHTING METHOD

Read all cautions before lighting candle. Adult supervision required!



- **1.** Always use the aluminum pan when lighting your glass votive candle. Fill the aluminum pan with water. Place the pan on a flat surface, away from paper or any other flammable material.
 - **Important:** Read all cautions on page 1 before lighting candle.
- **2.** Set a completed candle inside the aluminum pan filled with water.
- **3.** Ask an adult to light the candle for you.
 - Do not touch glass jar while candle is lit.
 - Do not move aluminum pan while candle is lit.
 - Do not leave lighted candles unattended.

LIGHT ONLY ONE CANDLE AT A TIME IN THE ALUMINUM PAN!
