

How to attach the Leaves

Step(7)

- **A**. Measure an approximately 14 inch (36cm) piece of stem wrap using the ruler guide on the last page.
- **B**. Start wrapping the stem wrap tightly around the stem, near the top as shown. A couple of turns should be enough.
- **C**. Then join the Leaves to the side of the flower as shown above.
- **D**. Continue wrapping the stem wrap until the stem is completely covered. Secure the paper to the bottom of stem with a small piece of clear tape (not included).



How to Display your Flowers



- 1. Locate your flower pot and foam.
- 2. Snap together the two sides of the flower pot.



Preparation



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

How to Shape Wires into Petals and Leaves



- **A.** Locate and match one of the Flat Molds to one of the Tall Molds by the same letters; *For example:* A to A, B to B and C to C.
- **B.** Next cut a piece of colored wire off the wire bunch, approximately 8 inches (20 cm) in length.


Note: Use the printed ruler on the last page as a guide to cut the wire to the correct size.



- A. Bend the Wire in half and form a loop.
- **B.** Place the Loop end of Wire around top area of the Tall Mold.
- **C.** Keep the loop down on Mold as you twist the ends of wires tightly all the way up to the arrow on Tall Mold as shown above.


Note: The arrow points to the end of the mold where the wires should twist.

How to Shape Wire in Flat Mold




A. Place the Wire Loop on top of one of the petal shapes on the Mold as shown.

Note: Make sure the wire fits as close as possible along the inside shape of petal.




- **B**. Once Wire Loop is in position use your fingers to push wire into the grooved area along the inside of the petal shape until it stays in place.
- **C**. Form the remaining petals on the Mold in the same manner and make sure they are in place.

How to Make the Petals and Leaves



- **A.** Next cut the Cups of paint apart using a pair of household scissors, with adult supervision.
- **B.** Dip your brush into any cup of paint and apply **a good thick coat** of paint into the open area, inside the Wire Loop as shown at right.
- **C.** Use as many different colors as you wish to make the various petals but don't mix wet colors together or petal may become muddy looking.

NOTE: Allow to dry thoroughly, approximately 8-12 hours or for best results, overnight.




How to Peel the Petals off the Mold

Step (5)

After waiting approximately 8-12 hours for the paints to dry, carefully lift up the Petals as explained below.

- **A.** Slowly and carefully lift the petals from the mold by lifting the wire stems upward.
- **B.** As you remove the petals from the mold, place them on the wax paper so they do not touch.

Note: If film separates from wire, put it back in mold and cover with paint again. Let dry and lift up again.



Added Note: You can also make tiny petals, no more than 1/4 inch (1/2 cm) in diameter, by hand twisting a petal shape and dropping it into a paint cup. Let dry on wax paper. You can twist the wire around a pencil for the proper size.




How to start making your Flower

- **A**. Gather the Petals you just made, the Stamen and twist together at the stems.
- **B**. Twist all the wire stems around the stem of the stamen until they are joined together.

Note: We suggest making 6 petals and two leaves per flower. Tiny petals (Step 6) look pretty around the Stamens.



C. After the stems of the Petals and Stamens are twisted together, carefully bend the petals downward and apart from each other.

Note: Arrange Petals in a circular pattern with Stamens positioned in the middle of the petals as shown. You can shape petals by gently bending or pinching wire to your liking.
