Cut your bricks or use the entire brick as shown here.

Attach bricks together using floral adhesive.

Choose your silk flowers and insert them into the DRY foam.

If you decide to use live flowers. Soak your bricks in a solution of **flower food** and water (always place foam on the surface of the solution and allow it to sink by itself for proper saturation).

Place wet bricks on a flat container.

Use these ideas and your imagination to make it your own.
