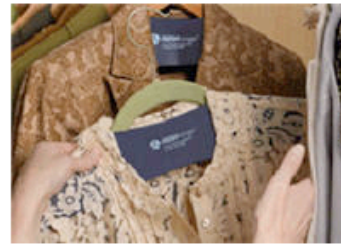

The 100% natural carbon material definitely had it's work cut out for it! I left it for 24 hours and when I came back the smell was actually noticeably better.
