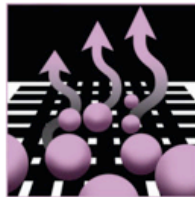

I am fortunate to have a job where I can wear pajamas scrubs that can be laundered easily without worrying about ironing. My husband does not fare as well. His pile of dry cleaning is threatening to come take over our bedroom. And...he waits forever to do it so we end up spending a lot of money on his dry cleaning bills. Sometimes I wish he could wear his clothes more than once but he's a guy...who sweats!

When it comes to my own dry cleaning, I would never think to wear an article of clothing twice because it's usually something I've worn out to dinner. I absolutely cannot stand the smell of food on clothing! Between the two of us our dry cleaning bill is definitely more than we'd like it to be.

I was recently introduced to a product called FRESHhanger, a cover you place on your hanger to help eliminate odors from clothing. Here is how it works:

I try to purchase eco-friendly products and really like that there aren't any harmful chemicals in FRESHhanger. In fact, the product actually absorbs the harmful chemical PERC, used by dry cleaners. Just think about the water and energy you'll be saving by not dry cleaning your clothes as often. I hung up some of my husband's shirts on hangers with FRESHhanger covers to test them out. When we pulled them out you couldn't even tell they had been worn. There was no odor whatsoever!
