## Fresh Hangers



Every now and then you come across a product where you say to yourself "Why didn't someone think of this sooner?". That is the case with *Fresh Hanger*. It's a very simple yet unique concept that is really a great idea.

*Fresh Hangers* are kind of like "slip covers" for your clothes hangers. They are a thick, padded piece of material that contains 100% natural active carbon. The carbon helps to absorb odors from your clothing.

Have you ever worn a shirt for a couple of hours and it's really not dirty but you rather have to wash it since you only wore it a very short time? Or do you let clothes pile up before you get the opportunity to get them to the dry cleaners? Or do you find that your closet or wardrobe tends to have a musty scent to it? If you answered "yes" to any of these questions then *Fresh Hangers* are for you.

I was a little sceptical at first when the *Fresh Hangers* arrived in the mail. Honestly I thought they would have some kind of a perfume scent to them to help "mask" any odors. I was wrong! There is no scent whatsoever in the *Fresh Hangers*. Even if you put your nose right up to them you can't smell a thing. That is great news because I highly doubt my husband would want to smell like a flower every day.

I used the *Fresh Hangers* in my husband's wardrobe. Because we live in a very tiny condo my husband's clothing has been reduced to whatever can fit inside a wardrobe. Sometimes it can smell musty or just "odd". I'm not saying my husband smells (no way!). I guess just over time things just start to develop a musty odor being cramped into the wardrobe. Sometimes he wears a shirt for a couple of hours and then takes it off right away when he gets home. As long as he doesn't sweat or spill anything on himself it makes no sense to wash a shirt after wearing it for two hours. That is why I knew *Fresh Hangers* might come in handy. Now whenever that opportunity presents it's self my husband just has to hang the shirt up on the *Fresh Hanger* and it will help absorb any odors that might be associated with the shirt.

We tried them for a couple of weeks and his wardrobe smells fine. I don't notice any odd odors at all. There is no scent really, which is fine. I used to some times spray inside the wardrobe with Febreze but I haven't had to do that since we started using the *Fresh Hangers*.

*Fresh Hangers* come in packages of 5, 10 or 20. You don't need to buy anything special. They simply slid over your existing hangers.

Each *Fresh Hanger* lasts for about six months. After that time you would need to purchase more. They are very reasonably priced so that shouldn't be a problem. Especially if it saves you trips to the dry cleaners or doing unnecessary laundry, especially for people like us who have to pay for laundry since we don't have a washer or dryer in our unit.

*Fresh Hangers* can reduce odors by 88% in about four hours and is 6X's more effective then just airing clothing out. Those are pretty impressive statistics.

Another "bonus" to the *Fresh Hanger* is that I noticed the clothing doesn't slide off of the hanger when there is a *Fresh Hanger* cover on it. That is great for us ladies who sometimes have a blouse that just won't stay on the hanger no matter what we try.
