All of the upholstery and wood products are hand crafted and finished in the USA. We take great pride in our products and want them to become your family heirlooms. Below are a few basic care instructions for your wood furniture, upholstery, and leather pieces.

Wood Furniture

- To maintain the quality of your wood furniture, do not expose it to direct sunlight or excessive temperature changes. A consistent home temperature and humidity level is the best environment for quality wood furniture. Dust your wood furniture often using a soft, clean, lint-free cloth. Don't expose your wood furniture to spills or water left behind from drinks or spills. Attend to spills immediately with a damp cloth. We do not recommend waxing, as the furniture will develop a beautiful patina thru age.

Upholstery

- To maintain the quality of your upholstered furniture, do not expose it to direct sunlight. All fabrics will fade when exposed to direct sunlight. Rotate cushions and vacuum beneath them regularly. Clean all pieces of the upholstery simultaneously to prevent any variance in color. Do not expose upholstery to spills or water. Blot spills immediately with a clean colorfast towel or sponge.

Leather

- For spills, immediately wipe with a soft white cloth dampened with distilled water and let air-dry. To keep the leather supple and prevent fading, protect it from the exposure of direct sunlight and heating vents.

Window Treatments

- To maintain the quality of your window treatments, reduce the expose to direct sunlight by ensuring UV ray protection has been applied to your windows. Direct sunlight will fade and over time deteriorate fabric fibers of your window treatments. Have your window treatments professionally clean annually and lightly dust often throughout the year. Any wrinkles and creases will fall-out of the window treatments over time. Do not steam your window treatments, as this could cause changes in the color.

Floor Covering

- Floor covering should be vacuumed weekly to ensure no dirt build-up. Have your area rugs professionally cleaned on an annual basis. Blot spills immediately.

Bedding

- Bedding should be washed/dry cleaned as directed on the Cobble Court Home label.
