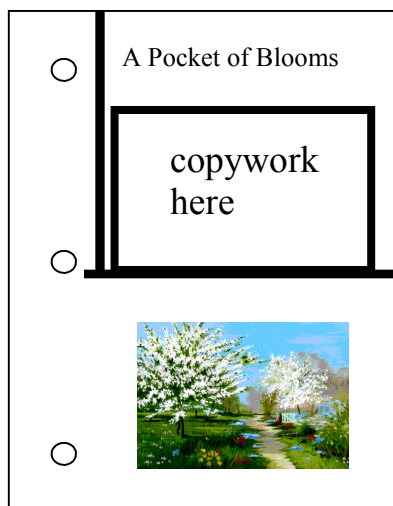

**Directions:**

- 1. Make one pocket by cutting along the dotted lines of page three and attaching to page four, using staples, glue or tape.**
- 2. Copy your quotes, lyrics, and poems daily during school time. Each week consists of two pages and has lines to copy right on that page. If you have a younger child that requires guidelines, please copy the lined work page as needed.**
- 3. After a complete week of copywork, cut around the edges of your paper and place into your pocket.**
- 4. Place pocket in a folder or three hole punch and place in a binder.**
- 5. Make a habit of memorizing at least one quote, poem, or lyric per week.**
- 6. We have double checked these quotes for accuracy. We know that many quotes or lines may seem wrong or misspoken but it is the way the author intended.**



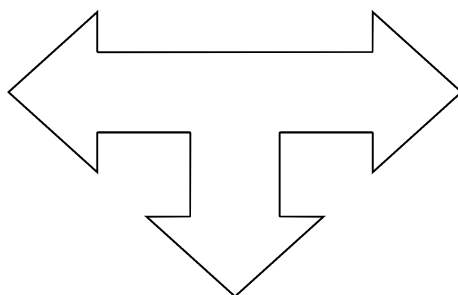


Cut along dotted lines.
