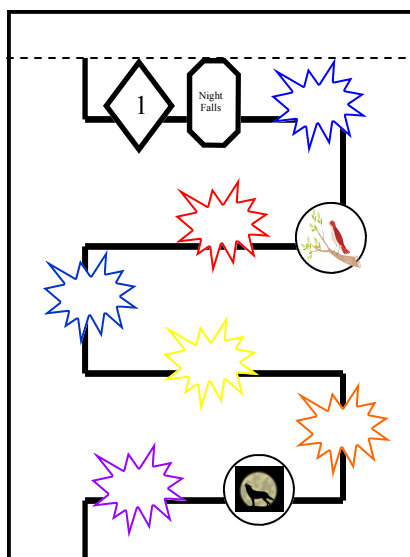

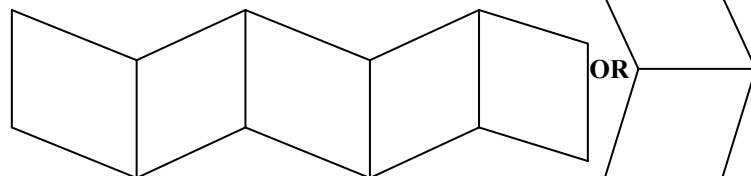
Directions

1. The blank timeline page (page 3) needs to be printed out for as many chapters the book contains. All other pages will be printed out only once.
2. As your child reads a chapter from the book, they will need to cut out the chapter's events (after they have been color coded), number, and graphics. To color code the event element simply color the planet banner or outline the edges of the square with the color specified. There are two graphics per chapter and will be about two events that took place in the chapter.
3. The student should decide if he would like to do a vertical timeline or horizontal timeline. All chapters need to be done the same way so the timeline can flow together by the end of the book.
4. Chapter number should go first on the timeline with chapter title following. Then the child will place the events in order on the timeline. Graphics can be placed on the timeline anywhere your child would like. Use the answer key to check for accuracy with events.
5. When the last chapter timeline has been completed, cut along the dotted line at the top (vertical) or left side (horizontal) of the timeline pages. There is no need to do this for chapter one.
6. Attach to the previous chapter by glue, staple, or tape. Fold the pages together, like the pleats of a fan, to create a timeline booklet. This booklet can be backed with cardboard on the first and last pages to create a hard cover booklet. The cover of the booklet can be the cover from this *Lines of Time* (simply print out) or students could also create their own artistic cover for their timeline.
7. You can also place your timeline on a wall at your home or in your classroom. This makes the progression always visible and anticipation ever present!

like this when stretched out.

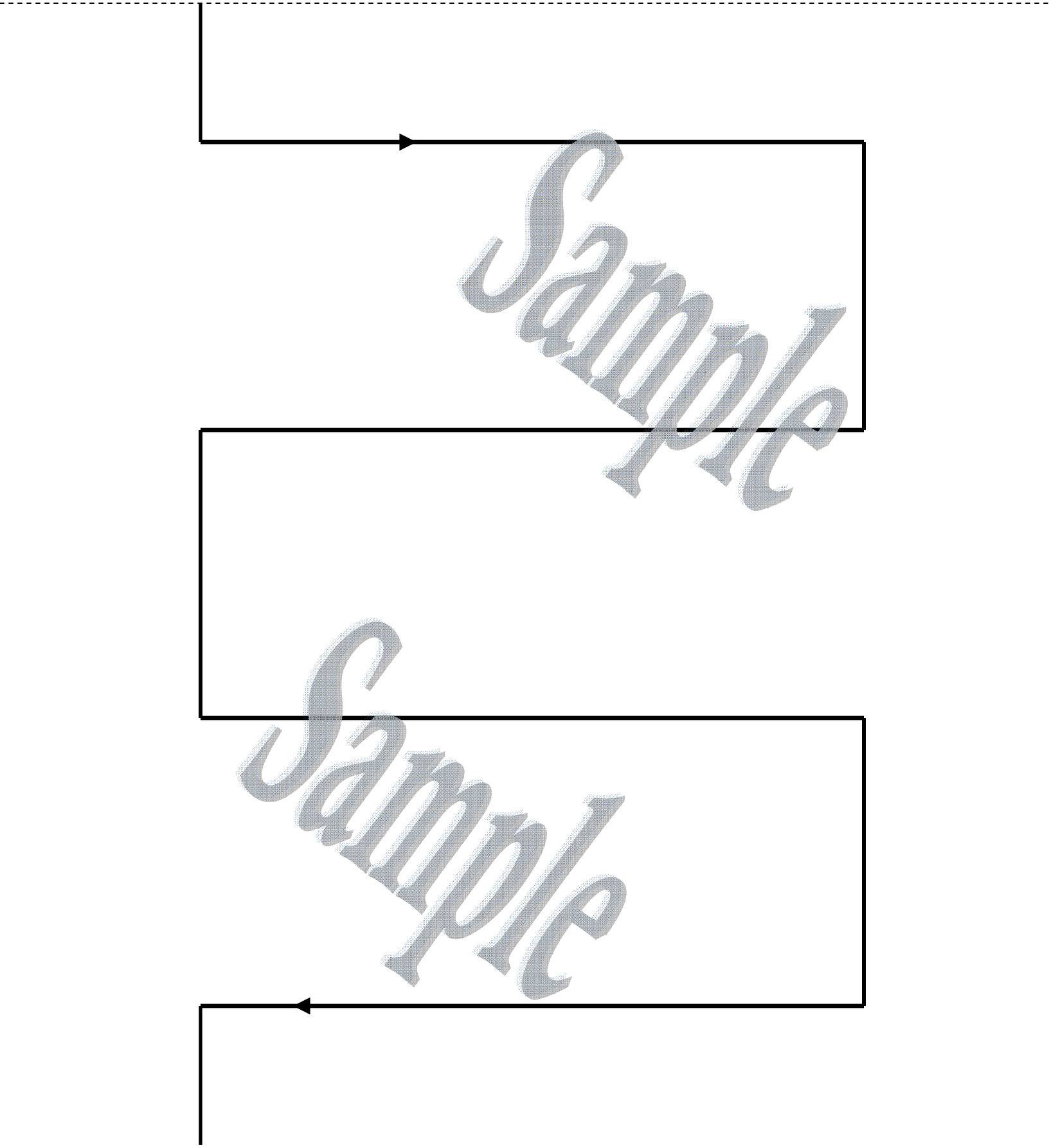

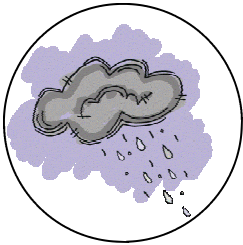
