## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Read all directions before assembling boxes. Turn the box so that the inside of the box is facing up. The score lines on the inside of the box form a ridge and the score lines on the outside of the box are slightly indented. Then fold on all score lines. The first diagram in the series will indicate which score lines are mountain folds and which are valley folds. All dash lines are valley folds (the fold points down to form a valley or a "V"). The solid lines are mountain folds (the fold points up to form a mountain).

Fold on score lines. Thread ribbon or raffia up through the two holes in the bottom flap. Fold sides in so they are flat and thread ribbon through the top two holes and tie in a bow. A sticker or seal may also be used to close the flap.
